

Embraced with the general test of ordinary care is the driver's duty to be reasonably vigilant and to keep the vehicle reasonably under control. Lutz v. Schendel (1959) 175 Cal.App.2d 140. A driver is expected to see those things that an ordinary prudent person would see. Leeper v. Nelson (1956) 139 Cal.App.2d 65. In this case, Ms. _____ was turning right from Simpson Avenue to her driveway when your insured struck her vehicle. Therefore, your insured is clearly negligent in this matter.
